

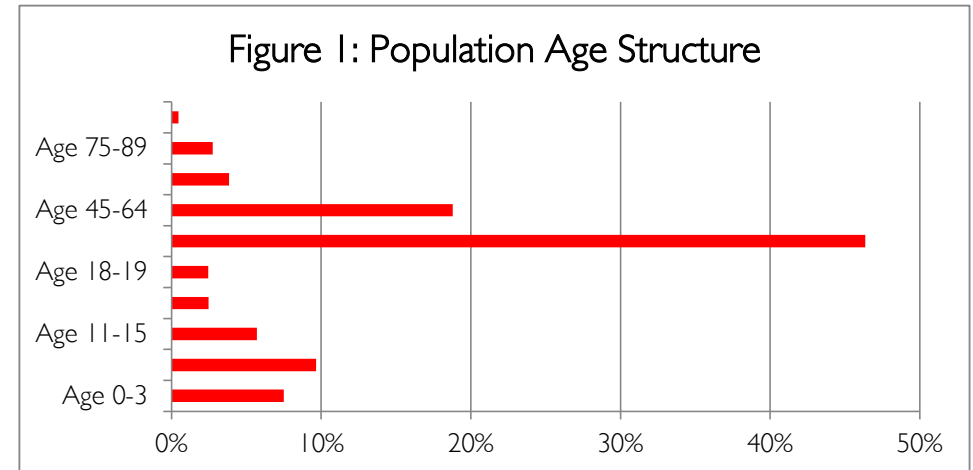

Figure I.2: Population Age Structure

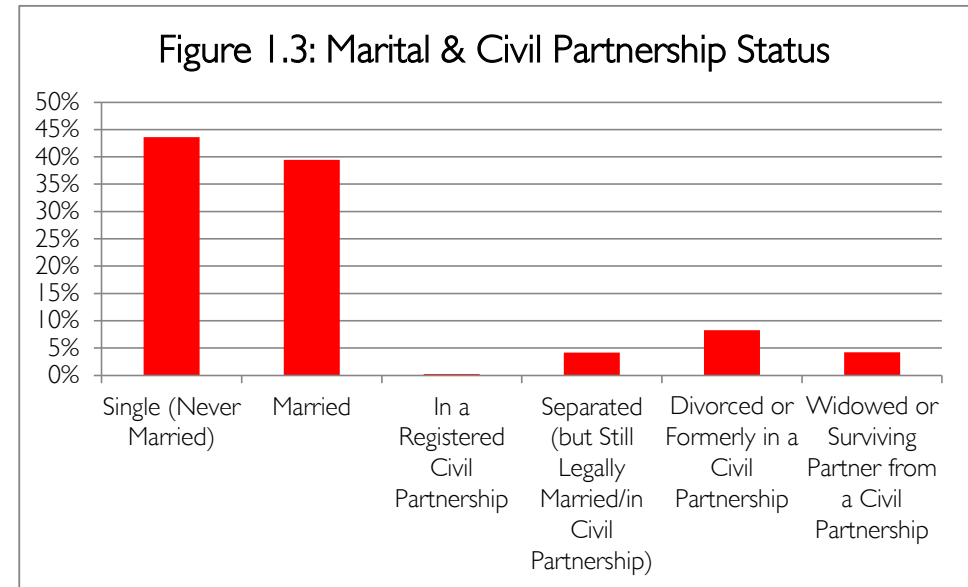

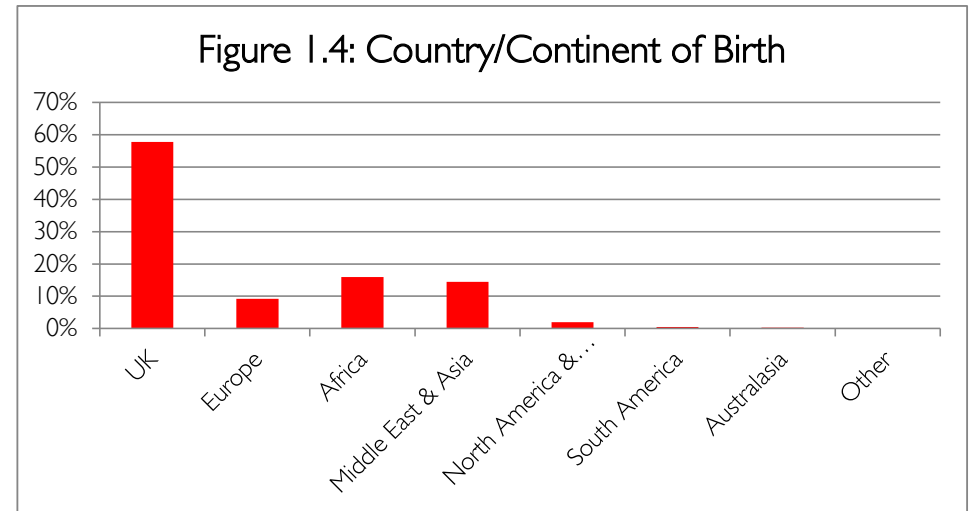

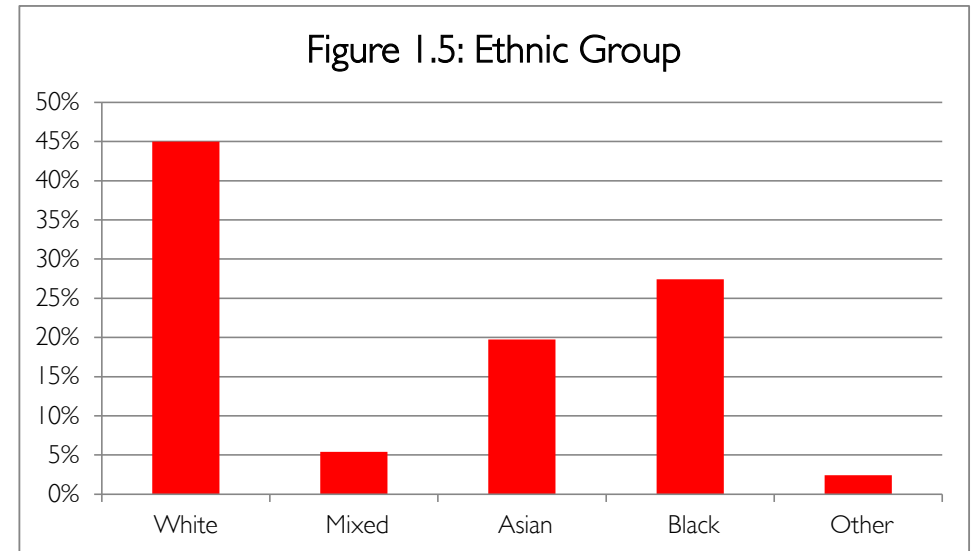

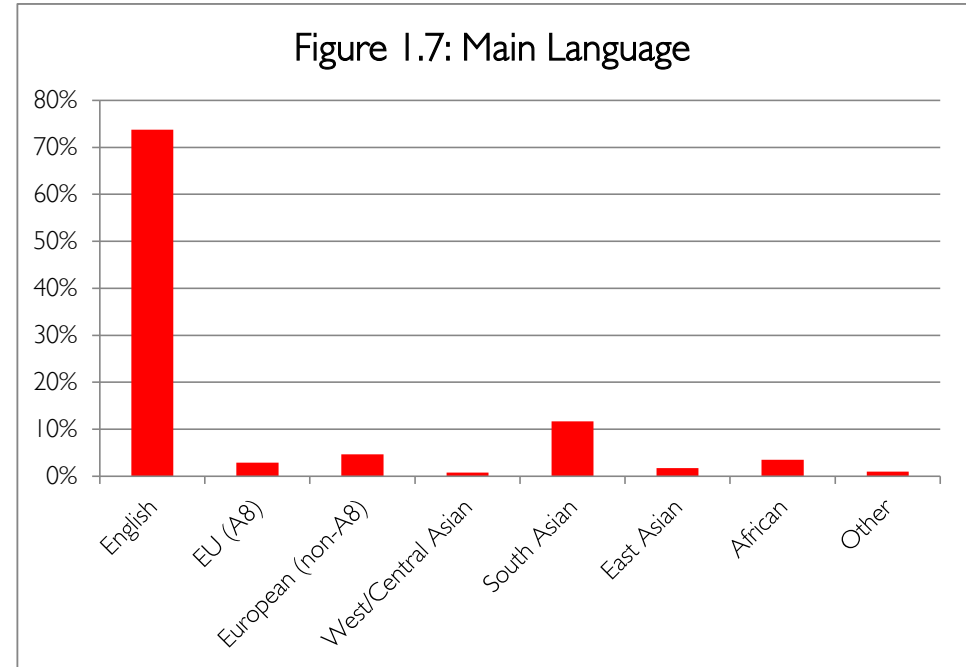

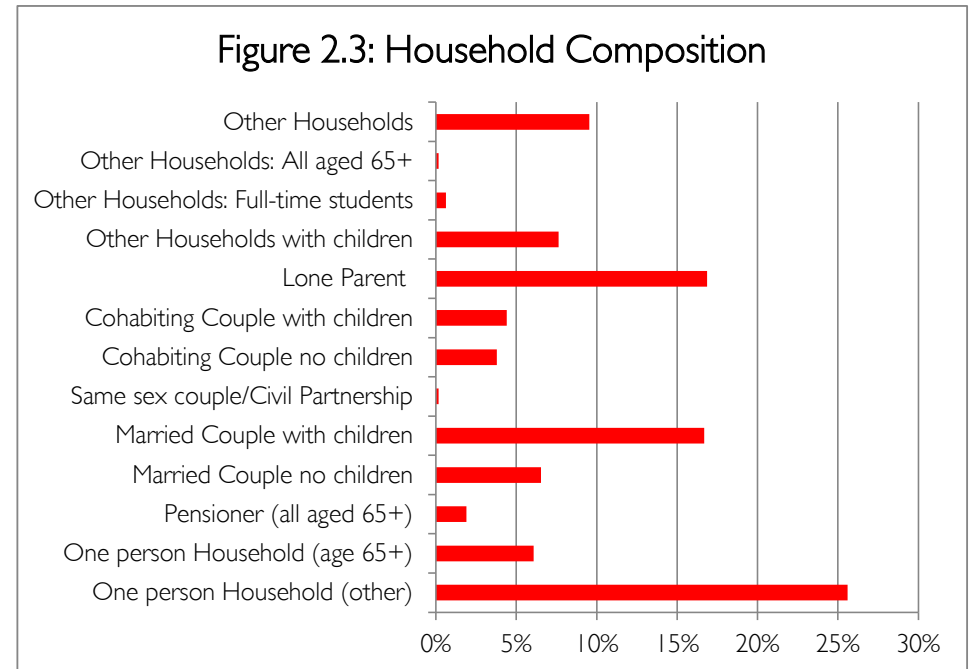

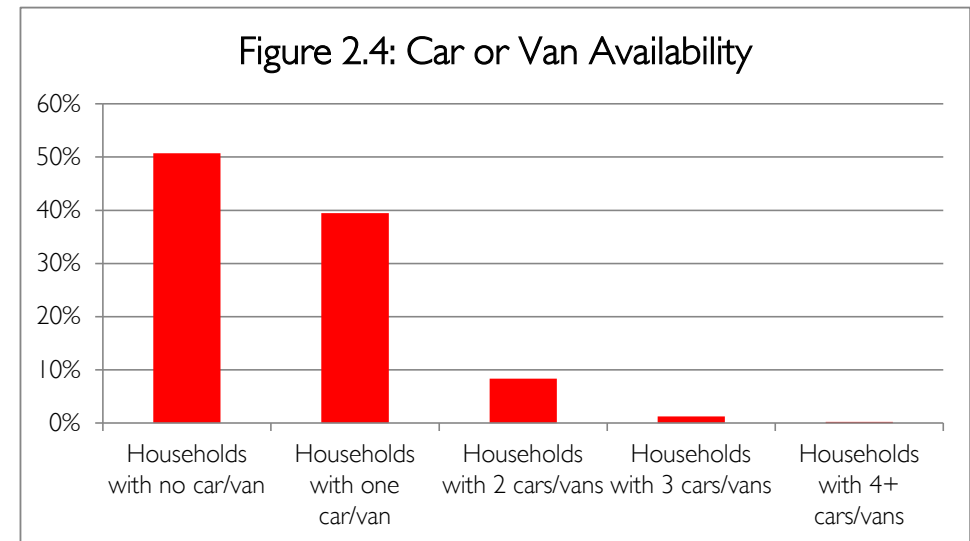

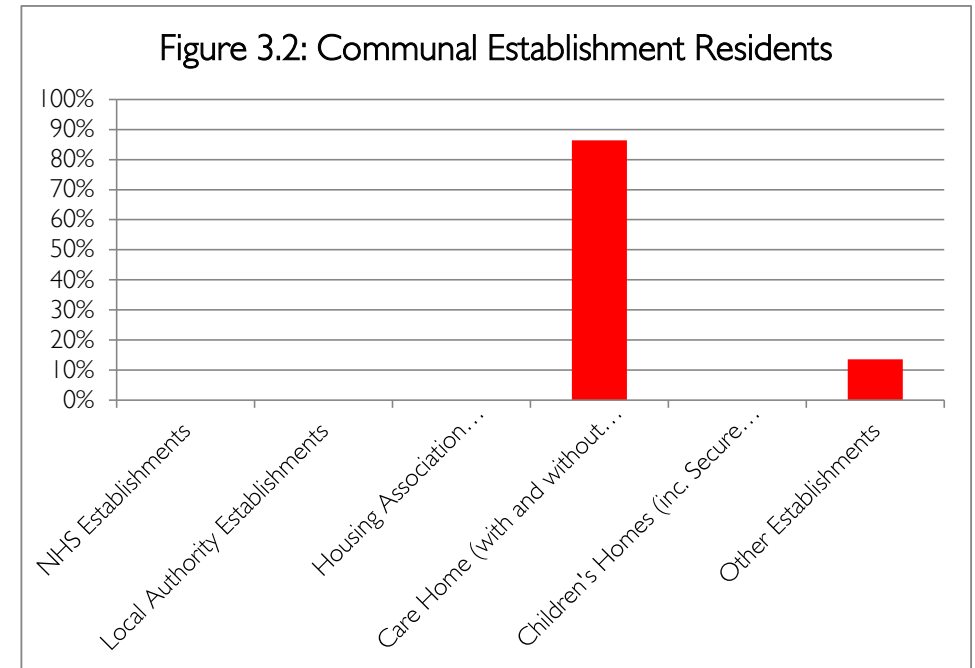

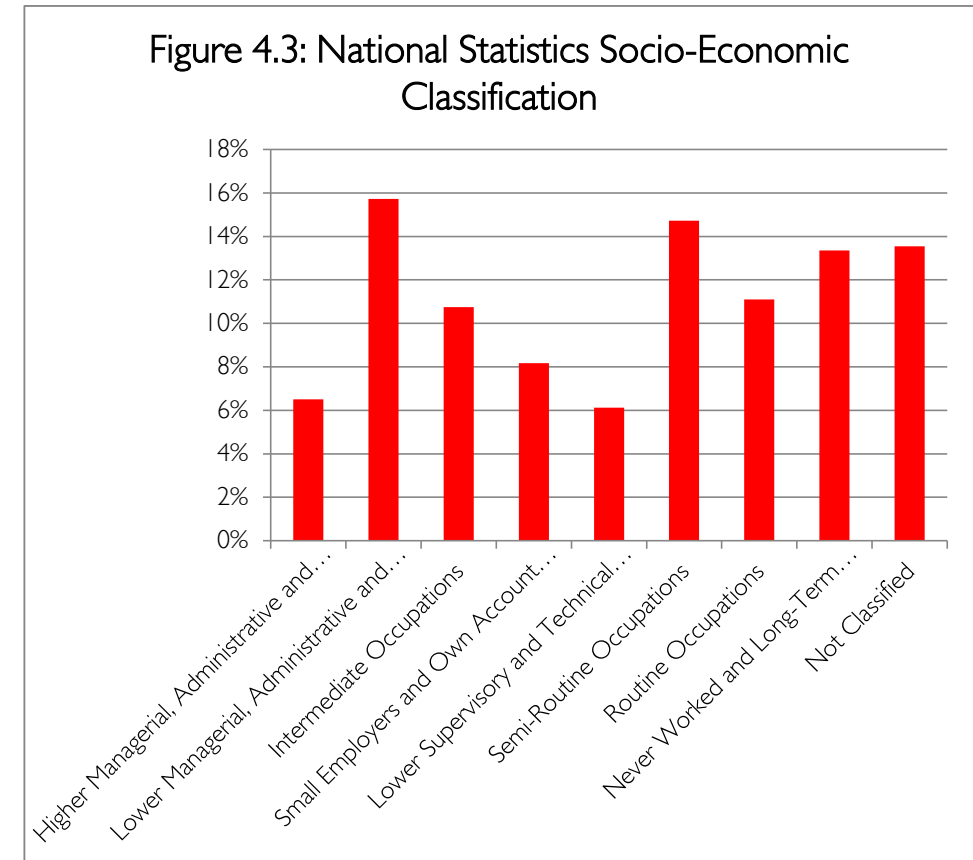
