WHEREAS James John Gillman Mayor of the LONDON BOROUGH OF GREENWICH hath represented unto The Most Noble Edward William Duke of Norfolk Earl Marshal and Hereditary Marshal of England THAT by Letters Patent under the hands and Seals of Garter Clarenceux and Norroy and Ulster Kings of Arms bearing date the First day of October 1965 certain Arms were granted and assigned unto The Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the London Borough of Greenwich THAT Her Majesty The Queen has indicated that She will be graciously pleased by Letters Patent to be issued on the Third day of February 2012 to confer upon the London Borough of Greenwich the title Royal and to ordain declare and direct that the said Borough shall thenceforth be called and styled the Royal Borough of Greenwich AND THAT the Council of the said Borough is desirous of having an alteration made to the said Arms and also of having a Crest and Supporters established under lawful authority and duly recorded in Her Majesty's College of Arms AND WHEREAS he as Mayor of the said Borough and on behalf of the said Council hath requested therefore the favour of His Grace's Warrant for Our granting and assigning such Arms as We deem suitable to be borne and used by The Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the London Borough of Greenwich in lieu of and in substitution for those previously granted and assigned as aforesaid and in the same Patent such Crest and such Supporters as We deem suitable to be borne and used by The Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the London Borough of Greenwich the whole on Seals or otherwise displayed according to the Laws of Arms AND FORASMUCH as the said Earl Marshal did by Warrant under his hand and Seal bearing date the Seventeenth day of November 2011 authorize and direct Us to grant and assign such Arms and in the same Patent such Crest and Supporters accordingly KNOW YE THEREFORE that We the said Garter Clarenceux and Norroy and Ulster in pursuance of His Grace's Warrant and by virtue of the Letters Patent of Our several Offices granted by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty to each of Us respectively do by these Presents grant and assign unto The Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the LONDON BOROUGH OF GREENWICH the Arms following that is to say Gules a Cannon Barrel erect palewise proper surmounted by a Lion's Face Or between two Hour Glasses Or a Chief nebuly of one point upwards Azure thereon a Chief nebuly of one point upwards Argent charged with two Mulletts Azure in lieu of and in substitution for the aforesaid Arms and by the same Authority We do further grant the following Crest that is to say Upon a Helm with a Wreath Argent and Azure On Waves Barry wavy of four Argent and Azure a fowl Anchor Or charged with a Tudor Rose barbed and seeded proper Mantled Gules lined Or And by the Authority aforesaid I the said Garter do further grant and assign the following Supporters that is to say On the dexter a representation of Zeus proper vested Gules murally crowned and holding in the dexter hand a Hartmann Astrolabe Or and on the sinister a representation of Neptune proper vested Azure crowned with a Naval Crown & holding in the sinister hand a Trident Or as are all in the margin hereof more plainly depicted the whole to be borne and used for ever hereafter by The Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the LONDON BOROUGH OF GREENWICH on Seals or otherwise according to the Laws of Arms IN WITNESS whereof We the said Garter Clarenceux and Norroy and Ulster have to these Presents subscribed Our names and affixed the Seals of Our several Offices this Third day of January in the Sixtieth year of the Reign of Our Sovereign Lady Elizabeth the Second by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and of Her other Realms and Territories Queen Head of the Commonwealth Defender of the Faith and in the year of Our Lord Two thousand and twelve'
