Section 80 of the Building Act 1984

Notice to Local Authority of Intended Demolition

80 (2) No person shall begin a demolition to which this section applies unless:-

- (a) he has either given the Local Authority notice of intention to do so, and
- (b) either:-
 - (i) the Local Authority has given notice to him under Section 81 below or
 - (ii) the relevant period (as defined in that section) has expired.

80 (3) A notice under subsection (2) above shall specify the building to which it relates and the works of the demolition intended to be carried out, and it is the duty of a person giving such notice to the Local Authority to send or give a copy to:-

- (a) the occupier of any building adjacent to the building.
- (b) any public gas supplier (as defined in Part I of the Gas Act 1986) in whose authorised area (as so defined) the building is situated and
- (c) the public electricity supplier (as defined in Part I of the Electricity Act 1989) in whose authorised area (as defined) the building is situated and any other person authorised by a licence under that Part to supply electricity to the building.

80 (4) A person who contravenes subsection (2) is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 4 on the standard scale.
