Resident's Place of Birth Profile

Key Findings

- The UK-born population of the Royal Borough is 175,645, accounting for 69% of the total population.
- Eltham North ward has the largest proportion of UK-born residents with 86.1%, whereas Glyndon ward has the lowest with 57.8%.
- The largest non-UK born population within the Royal Borough is African, accounting for 10.6% (27,017 people).
- Almost a quarter (24%) of Thamesmead Moorings ward residents were born in Africa (4,729 people).
- The Royal Borough has the highest proportion of Nigerian-born residents in London with 5.1% (13,013 people).
- The Royal Borough also has the 3rd largest proportion (2.1%) of residents from 'Other Southern Asian' countries in London, accounting for 5,291 people.

Royal Borough European-born [non-UK] Residents

- The non-UK born European population of the Royal Borough is 22,708, accounting for 8.9% of the total population.
- Greenwich West ward has the largest proportion of non-UK born European residents with 12.3%, whereas Eltham North ward has the lowest with 6.3%.
- Other Accession Countries (2001-11) accounted for 15.6% of the non-UK born European population, closely followed by the Irish population accounting for 14.4% the largest proportion of residents from an individual country.
- The Royal Borough has the 5th largest Lithuanian population across London, with 1,979 residents.

Royal Borough African-born Residents

- The African-born population of the Royal Borough is 27,017, accounting for 10.6% of the total Royal Borough population.
- Thamesmead Moorings ward has the largest proportion of African-born residents with 24%, whereas Eltham North ward has the lowest with 2.2%.
- The Nigerian population accounted for 48.2% of the total African-born population (13,013 people) – which is also the 2nd largest Nigerian population across all London boroughs.
- The Royal Borough has the 5th largest Zimbabwean population across London (962 residents).

Royal Borough Middle East & Asian-born Residents

- The Middle East & Asian-born population of the Royal Borough is 21,216, accounting for 8.3% of the total population.
- Plumstead ward has the largest proportion of Middle East & Asian-born residents with 18.8%, whereas Eltham North ward has the lowest with 3.6%.
- The Other Southern Asian population accounted for a quarter (24.9%) of this population, followed by the Indian population (20.6%) the largest proportion of residents from an individual country.
- The Royal Borough has the 4th largest Other Southern Asian population across London (5,291 residents) and the 6th highest population from both China and Hong Kong, with 1,918 and 1,101 residents respectively.

Royal Borough Americas-born Residents

- The Americas-born population of the Royal Borough accounts for residents born in North, Central and South America and the Caribbean.
- According to the 2011 Census, 6,504 residents were born in the Americas, accounting for 2.6% of the total population.
- Greenwich West ward has the largest proportion of Americas-born residents with 4.5%, whereas Eltham South ward has the lowest with 1.1%.
- The Jamaican population accounted for 30.9% of the Americas-born population, the largest proportion of residents from an individual country.
- Second to Jamaican, residents born in South America accounted for 25.2% of the Americas-born population.

Royal Borough Oceania & Other-born Residents

- The Oceania & Other-born population of the Royal Borough is 1,467, accounting for 0.6% of the total population.
- Greenwich West ward has the largest proportion of Oceania & Other-born residents with 1.6%, whereas Thamesmead Moorings ward has the lowest with 0.1%.
- The Australian population accounted for 60.9% of the total Oceania & Other-born population, the largest proportion of residents from an individual country.
- Second to Australian, the Other Australasian population accounted for 33.3%.
- The Royal Borough has the 19th largest Australian population across all London boroughs (894 residents).
