Context of Royal Greenwich and its Children and Young People

This section provides a summary of key demographic data relating to children and young people in the Royal Borough of Greenwich.

- According to Greater London Authority (GLA) population estimates¹, approximately 69,800 children and young people under the age of 18 years live in Royal Greenwich. This is 25% of the total population in the area.
- The GLA estimates that the under 18 population has risen 14% (8,300 children) since 2011, and will rise a further 3% (2,300 children) by 2021. The fastest growing age group will be 16 to 17 year olds (9% increase). This has implications for school place planning, admissions, and services we provide and commission.
- Children and young people from Black and minority ethnic groups account for approximately 64% of children aged 0-17 living in the area. This compares with 26% in the country as a whole.



Chart 2 Resident child population, by age and gender






