N.B. The onus to renew a permit rests with the applicant.

Applicants are reminded that the Royal Borough may require an applicant (or permit holder) to produce to an officer of the Royal Borough such evidence in respect of an application (or permit already granted) as they may reasonably call for to verify particulars supplied.
