We're making significant investments in the new Woolwich Leisure Centre, refurbishing the much loved Tramshed Theatre and restoring historic buildings in the Royal Arsenal to create the Woolwich Works arts hub.


Over £20 million funding has been secured from the government's Future High Street Fund and from Historic England for more improvements in and around the town centre.

This investment will ensure Woolwich is a vibrant and attractive place to live, work and shop, with excellent transport links, community facilities and public spaces.

WOOLWICH TOWN CENTRE

We're planning major improvements around Beresford Square, Powis Street, Hare Street and the surrounding areas and gateways that lead into Woolwich.



Past discussions and engagement have told us that residents, businesses and market traders want to:

- see improvements to the **look and feel** of the town centre while preserving Woolwich's unique character
- encourage a diverse mix of uses on the high street including new businesses, creative workspaces and events
- make it easier to get around within the town centre, creating better connections between the market and high street with the riverside, the Elizabeth line station, the Arsenal and surrounding neighbourhoods
- improve the look of shop fronts and find new uses for old buildings
- encourage more people to shop, eat and socialise in the town centre
- provide more trees and planting
- make Woolwich more resilient and flexible



We want to talk to local residents, businesses and community groups about how to deliver these improvements.







BERESFORD SQUARE

Space in Beresford Square is underused and offers a range of potential new opportunities. We want to celebrate the history of the square, attract more customers to the market and preserve the Royal Arsenal Gatehouse as a heritage asset





Improvements could include:

- installing better street lighting
- repaving the square and making the levels more even
- improving the layout of the market and providing new and better facilities for traders
- building a new Market Pavilion including new public toilets, supporting use of the market all year round
- celebrating the Royal Arsenal Gatehouse, providing additional useable space and introducing new uses on the ground floor
- adding new artwork and information about Woolwich's rich history
- providing more seating, trees and planting

POVIS STREET

KEY GATEWAYS AROUND WOOLWICH TOWN CENTRE

There are a number of different areas that lead into the town centre which could be improved.



We can improve connections between the market and high street with the riverside, the Elizabeth line station, the Arsenal and surrounding neighbourhoods, to encourage more walking and cycling. We can also take the opportunity to make these gateways more attractive and celebrate Woolwich's historic character.

Improvements could include:

- adding new artwork
- improving pedestrian crossings
- installing better street lighting and signage to help pedestrians and traffic
