nominations, so everyone should be extremely proud of making it this far.

These awards are about celebrating local businesses and their positive contributions to Royal Greenwich. Our businesses are the backbone of our local economy and community, bringing vital services, jobs and creativity to the borough.

This year, we introduced two new categories, Entrepreneur — Under 30, and Entrepreneur — Over 30, so it was exciting to receive entries which celebrate outstanding individuals as well as businesses.

Our finalists from across a diverse selection of businesses have demonstrated innovation, excellent customer service, fantastic training and development for their staff, and have gone above and beyond to support our communities.

With our vibrant town centres and superb transport links, Royal Greenwich is a popular and well-established location for businesses to start up and grow. The council's vision is to have a flourishing economy that nurtures new and existing businesses and offers opportunities to grow in an inclusive and sustainable way.

Our aim is to set the foundation to support even more businesses, creating 21,000 more jobs by 2030. We will do this by promoting local enterprise and start-ups, encouraging fair employment practices and ensuring that Royal Greenwich is attracting a range of companies.

We are also in partnership with the Living Wage Foundation to ensure employees are treated fairly and feel happier and secure in their jobs. This year we celebrated the news that 124 businesses have now been accredited as Living Wage Employers in Royal Greenwich, this has increased by 37% since 2022. This was helped by the council introducing a grant scheme to cover the full cost of three years' worth of accreditation from the Living Wage Foundation.

We know that this year has been tough for many of you, with the cost of living crisis at the forefront of many people's mind, so supporting local businesses has never been more important. We have a broad range of support on offer, from advice on training, networking, access to contract opportunities and an e-business support programme.

# VICKI'S LEGACY

At just 45, Vicki was a devoted physiotherapist, a loving mother to her children aged 10 and 7, and a fiercely loyal friend. Her warmth, humour, and competitive spirit touched everyone she met, from her school days at Thomas Tallis to her passionate support for West Ham and love of rugby.

When her illness brought her to the Community Hospice, the hospice team went above and beyond, ensuring she could spend cherished days at home with her children whenever possible.

"Whenever we spoke to Vicki about the hospice, she was so animated and told us how amazing the hospice team were. The nurses went above and beyond to ensure she was able to get home most days and be a mummy to her kids again which meant the world to her".

When she was too unwell to return home, the hospice team made sure they could still enjoy family time together. One evening, the team transformed the room for a cozy movie night, complete with teepees for the children, plenty of snacks, and all their favourite films.

Despite her illness, Vicki's spirit never wavered. She even organized an epic fundraiser for the hospice from her bed! In April 2024, Vicki died at the hospice, surrounded by love.

# The South East London Chamber of Commerce is in business for business.

Drinks which take place in every borough. Many free webinars take place and members' are invited to share their expertise in presenting these recorded events.

In 2024, the SELCC organised the Greener Greenwich Summit 2024 on behalf of the Royal Borough. This was Held at the Valley in March, and the event was free to RBG businesses. The 160+ attendees identified four project initiatives under four themes linked to RBG's Carbon Neutral Plan.

- Embedding Wider Change: All Greenwich businesses to develop a Carbon Footprint Action Plan.
- **Buildings and Energy:** Scale up energy and efficiency measures in domestic and non-domestic buildings.
- **Transport:** All organisations to develop a Green Travel Plan.
- Green & Digital: Employers to pledge their support to local colleges and universities to deliver the green and digital skills in the borough.
