• Seeing how important all of the different people in the borough are.



• Understanding the different needs that people have.

We also want to make a difference by:



• Helping people to understand and respect each other.



• Making the Royal Borough of Greenwich fairer by showing how people can be included and given a fair chance.



• Trying to stop **discrimination** or bullying.

**Discrimination** is when you are treated badly or unfairly because of your gender, race, religion, disability, health condition or sexual orientation.



• Helping people to do bigger and better things in their life.

#### What we will do



As an organisation, we will:

• Make people aware of why it is important to be fair to everyone.



• Work with other organisations and local people to make our information and services easier to use.



• Make sure we give everyone who wants to work for us a fair chance to find a job.



• Check that the people who work for us are from different backgrounds like the people who live and work in the Royal Borough of Greenwich.



As an organisation, we will also:

• Deal with any discrimination or bullying that people tell us about to stop it from carrying on.



• Help people from different backgrounds to work together.



• Share our ways of treating people fairly with other organisations that we work with.



• Keep checking how well we are being fair to everyone.
